Intellectual Disability And Assisted Reproduction

Assisted reproductive technology (ART) has been increasingly used for 40 years and now accounts for 4.3% of children conceived in Australia. Although considered a godsend by many, how much do we really know about the associated risks?

A recent study was published in the journal <u>Pediatrics</u>. This used Intellectual Disability (ID) and ART data from regions in Western Australia and found that children conceived using ART actually had a small increased risk of ID.

An innovative nurse shadowing program developed at the University of Colorado Health aims to improve the nurse-physician relationship. Participating residents described the experience as "humbling, given the number of responsibilities tasked to the nursing staff".

Two years on, the program continues to thrive and the time allotted for res idents shadowing nurses has actually been increased to 3 hours.
